

Lange Nacht der Museen

Saturday, 25.3.2023, 6pm – 1am



The entire Stuttgart art and culture scene in just one night!
During the "Lange Nacht der Museen" on March 25th, 2023, more than 60 museums, galleries, off-spaces, historic buildings, cultural and industrial monuments will open their doors from 6 pm to 1 am.

Visitors will discover well-known and hidden places with fascinating exhibitions, exciting guided tours, lots of visual art, architecture, music and a wide variety of special programs.

Many institutions will open their doors exclusively for the "Lange Nacht der Museen" such as the Marktplatz bunker, the New Castle in Stuttgart, the rainwater overflow basin or the data protection authority.

For the first time in more than three years, the Rolling Museum will also start again in the courtyard of the New Castle with spectacular classic cars.

Shuttle buses will connect numerous participating institutions on three tours and take visitors comfortably to their destination. In addition, the VVS Kombiticket, which is included in the Lange-Nacht-Ticket, can be used throughout the evening to get to all participating venues.

Program magazines with all the information will be available free of charge from February 24th at all participating venues, advance booking offices in Stuttgart and the entire region, and at numerous institutions.
